

GRADUATION DAY, Friday, May 31, 2019:

- ◆ ***Students should report to CPHS by 10:00 a.m.*** Graduates are required to meet at CPHS and ride the bus to the HEB Center. Students are assigned to rooms in alphabetical order and names will be posted on the rooms in the English hallway. **Be on time!**
- ◆ ***Graduates will not be allowed to take their cell phones with them to the HEB Center*** so choose a designated area to meet your graduate after the ceremony and make sure they are clear where that area is.
- ◆ ***Wear appropriate clothes:***
 - Boys – long pants, collared shirts, tie, dress shoes
 - Girls – dress or long pants and blouse and dressy shoes
 - Warning: Absolutely no athletic shoes, flip flops or jeans will be allowed
- ◆ ***Leander ISD does not allow graduates to decorate their mortarboard.*** Mortarboards will be checked at CPHS before graduates get on the bus. If a student has decorated theirs they will be required to purchase a new one for \$15.00. Herff Jones will be on campus with extras to sell.
- ◆ ***If your student received one of the academic honor cords approved by LISD, please make sure they bring it with them to put on when they put their cap and gown on.*** We do not have extras to give them if they forget it.
- ◆ ***Absolutely no cell phones, cameras, ipods, tablets, electronic devices, purses, sunglasses, etc. will be allowed.*** If a student brings anything with them to school, it will be locked in a secure area at CPHS and students can pick it up Friday afternoon from 3:00 – 4:00 p.m. or on Monday, June 3rd, during regular business hours. ***Nurse Frost will have a bag with emergency supplies.***
- ◆ ***Everyone who attends the graduation ceremony will go through metal detectors at the HEB Center.*** This includes graduates so please remind your student not to wear anything or bring anything that will set the metal detectors off.
- ◆ ***Do not bring any inappropriate items.*** If you have to ask, it's inappropriate.
- ◆ ***Students should bring their mortarboard (cap), tassel and gown with them to CPHS.*** Do not wear it. They will put it on in the marshaling area at the HEB Center.
- ◆ ***If your graduate will need a ride from the HEB Center to CPHS after the ceremony,*** please ask them to notify an AP at graduation practice or the teacher in your assigned room. The buses for band and choir students will stay to take them back to campus.
- ◆ ***No gum, candy or food allowed.***
- ◆ ***The graduation ceremony will be live streamed.*** The link for the live streaming will be available on the Leander ISD website approximately one week before the ceremony.

- ◆ ***Photo Texas Photography will be taking professional pictures of your graduate as they receive their diploma and again as they exit the stage.*** Order forms will be available at the CPHS receptionist desk.

- ◆ ***One of the most important reminders, **noisemakers are not allowed per The HEB Center.***** We ask that everyone be respectful of the graduate before, and after, yours and not make noise when it is their turn to receive their diploma. We want everyone to be able to hear their graduate's name! Please refer to the HEB Center Information Packet if you have questions about what is allowed.

- ◆ ***There are no tickets to the graduation ceremony.*** Seating is done on a first come, first served, basis. Please refer to the HEB Center information packet for information on handicap accessible seating and parking.

- ◆ ***Leander ISD provides 1 American Sign Language interpreter that will be shown on the Jumbo-Tron for the duration of the ceremony.***

Please review the HEB Center information packet that that is posted on the Cedar Park High School website. We ask that you share this information, or direct them to the website, with any family or friends who plan to attend so that they are aware of the rules set by the HEB Center.
