First day of school – Thursday, August 16th

High school starts at 8:40am. Students will report to the cafeteria the first day of school, Thursday, August 16, beginning at 8:00 to pick up their official schedule. We will have tables set up in the cafeteria for schedule distribution. Once they have their official schedule, students are to report to their first period class. There will be maps and teachers available that morning to help students locate their classrooms.

Students, on the first day of school be sure to come prepared to take notes and collect course documents. Teachers will provide more detailed supply requirements for specific classes on day one. If you are enrolled in advanced course(s) requiring summer assignments, be sure to come prepared with your assignments. Students who kept their school issued Lenovo laptop over the summer should bring their computer to school as well. Students may also bring personal devices (laptop, IPAD, etc).

Transportation

In order to ensure a smooth start, please adhere to the following transport guidelines:

For safety purposes: Students are required to enter the campus thru the main entrance or the side entrances from bus drop off, student parking or parent drop off.

Parents of band members and athletes: After 8:00 please do not enter through the East entrance bus entrance. Enter the campus off Anderson Mill road at Twin Creeks Country club near the tennis courts and proceed around the back of the campus and out the east side of campus on Cypress Creek Road.

Student drivers: Enter the campus off Anderson Mill Road on the west side of campus near the student parking lot.

Parent drop-off: Enter the campus off Cypress Creek Road on the west side of the campus and make the loop to drop students off.

Buses and CPHS staff: Enter the campus off Cypress Creek Road on the east side of the campus. The east entrance will only be open to buses and personnel after 8:05 a.m. on Monday.
